Therefore, we strongly encourage all students to apply for financial aid by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). You can apply for financial aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. This determines financial need and ensures that awards are distributed to as many students as possible.

You must submit your scholarship application no later than June 12, 2009. For priority review, applications are considered as they are received. Scholarship applications may be submitted to the Office of Student Financial Aid at any of the three campuses. Please complete your application carefully and thoroughly as early as possible.

If selected for a scholarship, recipients must agree to:

- Send a letter of thanks to the scholarship sponsor
- Send a copy of the letter to the Office of Student Financial Aid
- Attend a meeting of the club or organization if requested
- Attend the Montgomery College scholarship recognition event to thank donors and promote the scholarship program

We will make every effort to review applications in a timely manner and notify recipients as quickly as possible. If you have any questions, please visit or call your campus Financial Aid Office.
