Explanation of Request:	The senior vice president for advancement and community engagement is requesting an award of contract for strategic communications.
	Contract services will include the creation of a cohesive and aligned communications strategy that enhances visibility, credibility, and support among key stakeholders. This partnership will enable Montgomery College to leverage more effective and efficient communication across all departments, ensuring consistent messaging that aligns with its transformational aspirations. The firm will provide guidance to proactively manage potential issues impacting the College's reputation while enhancing positive earned media coverage.
	A unified communications strategy will improve how Montgomery College shares resources, achievements, and opportunities with students, fostering a sense of belonging and engagement. Effective communication can help students connect with programs, support services, and partnerships that facilitate their academic, career, and personal growth. Ultimately, this aligns with the College's focus on access, completion, and post-completion success, driving positive student outcomes.
	Without these services, the College may face fragmented communications, leading to inefficiencies, internal silos, and diminished stakeholder engagement. Inconsistent messaging will negatively impact the College's ability to address reputational risks proactively. This gap may weaken support from students, faculty, staff, and external partners, ultimately impacting student retention and success by reducing awareness of critical

WHEREAS, Contract services will include the creation of a cohesive and aligned communications strategy that enhances visibility, credibility, and support among key stakeholders, enable Montgomery College to leverage more effective and efficient communication across all departments, ensuring consistent messaging that aligns with its transformational aspirations; and

WHEREAS, The director of procurement certifies that specifications and contract documents were developed by appropriate College staff and consultant, and the chief business/financial strategy officer certifies that funds are available in the FY25 operating budget; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Md. (Educ.) Code Ann. Sec. 16-311(c), a Request for Proposal was publicly advertised on August 23, 2024, on the Montgomery College Procurement and the State of Maryland eMaryland Marketplace Advantage websites; and

WHEREAS, 97 firms downloaded the Request for Proposal from the Montgomery College procurement website, of which, 70 were identified as minority business enterprises; and

WHEREAS, Seven responses were received, read aloud, and recorded in the office of procurement, beginning at 3:00 pm on September 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Upon evaluation of all vendor proposals by appropriate College staff, it was determined that the proposal submitted by The Hatcher Group of Bethesda, Maryland, was the highest ranked, meeting all College requirements; and

WHEREAS, This resolution aligns with Montgomery College Strategic Plan Goal 1: Enhance connections between Montgomery College and our community, and Goal 2: Cultivate a sense of belonging for everyone at the College; and

WHEREAS, Awards resulting from competitive sealed proposals valued above \$250,000 require Board of Trustees approval; and

WHEREAS. The president of the College recommends the following action; now therefore be it

Line 5	This deletion improves clarity and meaning.
Line 6	This deletion improves clarity and meaning.
Line 6	This modification updates language to use the broader and more accurate term "College property."
Line 8	This modification improves readability.
Line 9	This addition expands the description of what the viewpoint neutral regulations seeks to protect.
Lines 9-12	This addition emphasizes and further explains that the policy is viewpoint neutral.
Lines 14-17	This modification is for clarity and meaning and to mirror language in other policies.

Lines 19-20	This modification reflects standardized language being implemented across all policies.

<u>Resolved</u>, That Policy 75004: Freedom of Expression be amended as indicated in the attached draft; and be it further

Resolved, That the president is authorized to implement these changes.

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Chapter: **Facilities** Modification No. 003 Subject: Freedom of Expression I. Montgomery College supports the rights of the College community to exercise their First Amendment right to freedom of speech, freedom of the press, freedom of expression, and the right to peaceful assembly. II. These activities must not disrupt the operations of the College. Accordingly, the time, place, and manner of exercising speech on College property are subject to regulations that shall provide for non-interference with College functions, reasonably protect individuals against practices which would make them involuntary audiences, and respect each person's right to choose whether or not to participate. All expressive activities shall be treated equally and therefore regulations to time, place, and manner shall be established and enforced without regard to the content or viewpoint of the expressive activity. III. Persons engaged in expression shall make it clear that their actions are an expression of their own individual viewpoint and do not represent the College's position as an institution. IV. The Board of Trustees authorizes the president to establish any procedures necessary to
