- · Curriculum Vitae (CV) or Resume: Highlighting relevant experiences, achievements, and contributions related to supporting students and gender equity (maximum 2 pages).
- Supporting Documentation: Optional but encouraged. This may include testimonials from students, colleagues, or other supporting materials that demonstrate the nominee's influence and impact.
- · Submission Deadline: Please submit all nomination materials by November 15, 2024.
- Selection Process: A selection committee composed of Women and Gender Studies Program representatives will review all nominations. They will evaluate each nominee based on the details above.
