Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) and Montgomery College (MC) have an articulation agreement for <u>Early Child Development</u> and <u>Early Childhood Education</u> programs. For all of the programs listed above, students <u>may</u> earn college credits toward their college degrees or certificates through their Career and Technology program if they earn a C or better in each of their high school courses associated with the program of study. Students will receive credit upon their full admission to the College in an applicable degree program listed below on page 3.

Student Procedures:

- 1. Submit an <u>application for admission</u> to MC and list your major as one of the following: Early Childhood 1 Year Certificate (177), AAS (315), OR AAT (604).
- 2. Print this Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form.
- 3. Ask the high school registrar to attach a copy of your official sealed transcript to the Articulation Credit Award Form.
- 4. Print and sign your name below to signify that you have read the Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form and you understand the requirements of earning credit at Montgomery College (MC).
- 5. Submit the completed Articulation Agreement Credit Award Form with your student Portfolio, Daily Log of Activities and any other documentation including evaluations of internship to: Montgomery College, School of Education Early Childhood Education, 51 Mannakee Street 406M, Rockville, MD, 20850.
