- ‡ Students should attempt ENGL and MATH foundation requirements within completion of the first 24 credits of college-level work or at the completion of any prerequisite or required non-credit coursework.
- ‡‡ Any credit hours beyond the minimum General Education credit hours (31) or core courses are counted toward elective credit hours.

NOTE: Exact semester credit counts may vary based on specific course selections.

## MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY NOTES

Students that complete the Associate of Arts degree at Montgomery College will be considered core complete at Marymount University, with the exception of one core course in theology (TRS 100). It is possible to complete the remaining requirements for the B.A. in Psychology within 4 semesters when working carefully with an academic advisor. Students that do not complete the Associate of Arts degree at Montgomery College will need to complete additional courses to fulfill Marymount's Liberal Arts Core requirements.

Most minors at Marymount are 15 credits, or 12 additional credits if students have taken a course in the minor field such as communications, sociology, political science, law, or criminal justice.

Many Psychology courses at Montgomery College count toward the Psychology major at Marymount; see the Marymount website for an updated list. Each Psychology course taken at Montgomery College that also counts as a Marymount Psychology requirement or elective reduces the total number of Psychology requirement or elective courses needed to be taken at Marymount. PSYC 202 = PSY 900 (general elective course); PSYC 203 = PSY 110 (required course for PSY major); PSYC 204 = PSY 396 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 206 = PSY 396 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 207 = PSY 321 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 211 = PSY 220 (required course for PSY major); PSY 213 = PSY 312 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 215 = PSY 902 (general elective course); PSYC 216 = PSY 312 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 221 = PSY 230 (required course for PSY major); PSYC 224 = PSY 325 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 227 = PSY 396 (PSY 300/400 elective); PSYC 228 = PSY 260 (required course for PSY major).
