Most Nursing Programs and other Health majors listed above require passing scores on the TEAS Test for admission. The Test of Essential Academic Skills [TEAS] is typically taken after completing Anatomy I and II; however, there are several sections of the TEAS test that you can begin studying for in your first semester at Montgomery College. Spreading your studying for the TEAS over several semesters may better prepare you for the actual test.

What is on the TEAS Test? The ATI TEAS Version 7 Test has 170 total questions, with 209 minutes of testing time. "Question types include multiple choice, multiple select (select all that apply), fill in the blank, ordered response and hot spots." ("ATI TEAS Exam Details - ATI Testing")

Online Practice TEAS Test from ATI - offered by ATI, the company that gives the TEAS test. Cost is \$50. Students have said that taking this very realistic timed online version of the test gives them a better sense of what their true score will be in each section. It provides information about correct and incorrect answers to allow concentration on the sections where improvement is needed before taking the real test. https://atitesting.com/teas/practice-assessment

MC Allied Health Programs focus on two specific scores: Reading Comprehension – Minimum score 70%, and AITS (= Total Score) - 66%. View MC's Allied Health Programs Points Chart for TEAS Scores and priority courses.

When To Take the TEAS? Most students allow time to take the test twice if needed, so count backwards from the application due dates. If your application deadline is March 1, plan to take the test in January for the first time and then again in February to allow for the 30-day wait period between tests. You will get your scores immediately when you finish the test, so this helps you know whether you need to take it again.

MC TEAS Test Retake Policy – 30 Days: For Montgomery College Nursing and other Health Program Admissions, you must wait at least 30 days between TEAS tests. MC Deadlines are August 1 for Spring (Nursing) and April 1st for MC Nursing – Fall entry or March 1 for Fall all other MC Allied Health programs.
