Subject: Resource Planning Tool Kit Update

Please find attached an updated version of the Resource Planning Toolkit. This report contains discipline and program data related to costs, enrollment, completion, and productivity. Where possible, all disciplines and programs have been mapped to the appropriate Vice President/Provost and Collegewide Dean. We ask that you please validate these assignments and let us know if there are any errors so that we can correct them promptly.

In reviewing the data, we have made several observations about the data and have developed the following comments to guide the review of each section:

Discipline Costs

- Review Discipline Costs – what are the outliers and what are the implications for expanding certain disciplines?

Student-Faculty Ratios

- Majority of disciplines are not at 20.0 or above
- How can we increase productivity to improve ratios?

Highest Enrolled Courses Observations

- Majority of largest enrolled courses are within General Education
- There is not much variation between the Total CW courses and those on the campuses

Sections per Campus Observations

- Several disciplines have less than 10 sections Collegewide – what should the guidelines be for specific offerings?

Program Enrollment

- This data is dependent upon students verifying their major early and often. Banner does allow students to verify their major when they register. Currently we are not using that feature.
- Look at ways to encourage students to declare sooner to ensure they are taking the proper classes
- Letters of Recognition are not required for MHEC reporting and the numbers are declining – should we explore transitioning some of these into Certificates?

Number of Degrees/Awards Granted

- In the past, MHEC required a response from any program that failed to graduate more than 15 students in a three year period – should we adopt the same measure for internal reviews?

Program Transfers/Top Program Transfers

- Look at Graduated & Transferred column compared to Transferred – No Award – how can we incentivize completion to increase the number of students who transfer with a degree?

Four-Year Graduation/Transfer Rate

- How can we increase the number of students who complete their degree prior to transfer?

Time and Credits to Award

- Note the average number of credits accumulated for each program
- How can we encourage and/or notify students to apply when they have accumulated enough credits for a certificate or letter of recognition?

Low Producing Programs

- Review low producing programs according to MHEC guidelines (must have >15 within 3 years)
- How should we address the School of Arts and Design cohort model to improve productivity and scheduling?
