It is my pleasure to announce the appointment of Ms. Ida Britton as the Administrative Manager in the Office of the Vice President and Provost (VPP), Rockville, beginning April 3, 2023. Ms. Britton holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from Georgetown University and a master's degree in counseling from the University of the District of Columbia.
