I am pleased to announce the appointment of Ms. Transcie Almonte-Sabio to serve as the acting dean for Business, Information Technology, and Safety (BITS). Ms. Almonte-Sabio brings over 16 years of program development and management experience at Montgomery College to the position, which she started June 2.

Ms. Almonte-Sabio joined Montgomery College as a senior program assistant in 2007 developing and delivering open enrollment and contract courses. She was selected as the acting program director in 2009 and program manager in 2012, providing oversight, leadership, and guidance for successful outcomes for students in management and leadership, human resources, and project management programs, in addition to her previous duties.
