Specifically, the Facilities Master Plan reviews the conditions of existing facilities and defines the College's future needs outlined in the College's strategic plan. The Maryland Higher Education Commission uses the plan to ensure the College is prepared to meet the needs of residents for postsecondary education and subsequently uses the plan to assess the College's requests for new and modernized facilities.
